


1. What Can We Do To Help? Proposal

- b. Make a proposal on how HTMNC can help with current situations in regions around the world.

Student Activities Proposal

Your student club/organization must submit a proposal for any event or activity that is open to the campus and to the public, or for the purchase of any and all items related to the club and its activities.

Your student club's Leadership Council must submit the following items:

I. COVER PAGE

- Name of Club
- Name of the member submitting the proposal (this person must be on the Leadership Council) along with contact email address
- Semester (Fall or Spring and Year)
- Date Submitted

Include the above items centered on the Cover Page.

- Is it a Campus-wide Event? If yes, write "Campus-Wide Event."
- What is the Event title?
- What is the Amount Requested, if any?

Include the above items on the bottom-left-hand side of the Cover Page.

II. Form submission (See below)

III. (IF APPLICABLE) Submit Supporting Documents

1. Budget Request (See sample below)
2. Screen shots from vendor websites
3. Invoices

- Step 1: Research nonprofits and NGOs that help in your country of origin or region of that country.
 - Research at least 7 organizations that serve this part of the world.
 - What issues do these organizations try to address?
 - How do they address these issues?
 - How can people support their organization?
- Step 2: Select 1 organization that you think is doing the best work.
 - Write a persuasive paragraph about why you think this organization is doing the best work.
 - Explain how this organization stands out from the others.
- Step 3: Draft a one page proposal which includes the following sections:
 - Title - (ex: What can we do to help in Asia?)
 - Your persuasive paragraph
 - Logo of the organization
 - Picture of the organization doing work
 - What issue does this organization try to address?
 - How do they address these issues?
 - How can people support this organization right now?
- Step 4: Get critique
 - Make sure it follows the rubric
- Step 5: Apply critique
